

## Information regarding crimes and anti-social behaviour for each area in December 2017

**WB43/BC01 - Crimes** – A male slapped a mobile phone out of another male's hand in a verbal argument at Cleveley Bank Lane. Two males entered into a verbal altercation at a service station on the A6 after a road traffic incident. A male offender paid for a phone top up card at Forton services, took a photo of the activation code and then returned the card, obtaining a refund and then activating the top up.

**ASB** – Staff reported a male being abusive when a gaming machine at Forton services wouldn't pay out. A male in Forton reported being threatened by another male in a tenancy dispute. A resident reported two vehicles revving engines on Snow Hill Lane, Scorton. A resident reported Long Lane at Scorton flooding.

**WB44/BC02 – Crimes** – Unknown offenders broke into a vehicle parked at Topiary Gardens and stole sports clothing and equipment. A male took a taxi to a property on Garstang Road and did not pay the fare. A resident in a care home assaulted two members of staff and broke the glass on a fire alarm. An unknown offender stole a coat from the cloakroom at Garstang Country Hotel.

**ASB** – There were three reports of further incidents in ongoing neighbour issues on Gryersale Drive. There was a further report in a neighbour dispute on Dewlay Court.

**WB45/BC03 – Crimes** – A male in Garstang reported that he was being harassed by another male. A blue recycling bin was taken from a property on Green Lane.

**ASB** – None.

**WB46/BC04 – Crimes** – An unknown offender fraudulently used a Garstang resident's bank details on an online betting site. A female in Garstang was assaulted in a domestic dispute. A male threatened another male with violence after an incident in Aldi car park. An unknown offender stole a bag of cash from a charity stall outside the Eagle and Child during the Victorian Festival. An unknown offender smashed a window at Richard Seed Stationers. A group of unknown males kicked and punched a male who had fallen after slipping on ice near the King's Arms. A female was assaulted by another female in a fast food take-away and her bag was stolen by an unknown offender during the fight. A female was escorted forcibly from a property in Garstang during a family dispute. A female in Garstang was sexually assaulted by a male known to her. A female was assaulted in a public house after complaining about a male spitting on the floor. A male was assaulted by another male on Green Lane. An unknown offender stole a bag that had been left on a trolley at a town centre store. A male offender has been interviewed with regards to an alleged rape. Unknown offenders stole an amount of alcohol from a town centre store. A male was arrested on the A6 for driving under the influence of cocaine and for possession of cocaine.

**ASB** – A group of young males were reported to be causing problems in the Wheatsheaf. A resident in Cabus reported a young male selling household items door to door, concerned it could be a scam. A male walking his dog on Lancaster Road was verbally abused by another dog walker. A male reported receiving a number of unwanted communications from a female.

**WB47/BC05 – Crime** – Unknown offenders broke into shipping containers at a building site on Joe Lane and stole diesel and batteries. They also ransacked the site. An unknown offender filled up with £30 of fuel at a petrol station and drove off without paying.

**ASB** – A female in Churchtown reported being harassed by another female. A male in Catterall reported two males who he believed were dealing drugs and acting antisocially. A female at a property on Cock Robin Lane reported that a number of uninvited males were trying to gain access to a party. Another resident complained about the anti-social behaviour spilling out from the same party. A passer-by reported smelling cannabis being smoked from a white ford focus car on Catterall Playing Field.

**WB48/BC06 – Crimes** – Offensive Christmas lights were reported on Beaconsfield Terrace. A male was reported to be threatening violence towards a female at a public house on the A6 in Bilsborrow and a male was assaulted during a separate incident at the same location. Both registration plates were taken from a vehicle parked on the car park at Bilsborrow village hall..

**ASB** – A female reported that a customer barred from a local public house was spreading malicious gossip about her. A resident on the Willows, Bilsborrow, reported that there were a number of people causing nuisance. A driver was reported for deliberately driving through a puddle splashing an adult pedestrian and their children and then the driver started shouting obscenities at the pedestrians. Both parties were spoken to.

**WD07/BC07 – Crimes** – A female was assaulted in a domestic dispute in Great Eccleston. An unknown offender smashed a window of a vehicle parked in West End, Great Eccleston. An unknown offender removed batteries and cut wires on plant machinery on Lancaster Road, Out Rawcliffe. An unknown offender gained entry to two secured vehicles on Derby Crescent, Inskip, but left without taking anything. An unknown offender kicked in the bottom panel on a door to enter a property on Keda Hall Lane, Great Eccleston, and stole cash and other items. A male in Great Eccleston was assaulted in a domestic dispute.

**ASB** – A female in St Michaels reported that a female was causing nuisance at her address. A resident in St Michaels reported loud music coming from a nearby property.

**WD08/BC08 – Crimes** – A quantity of wood was stolen from Park Lane, Winmarleigh. A female in Pilling reported a malicious communication being circulated. A wheelbarrow and a bulk bag of tree wood was stolen from a wood store on Park Lane, Winmarleigh. A female in Pilling was assaulted in a domestic violence incident. An unknown offender scratched a vehicle parked on Lancaster Road, Pilling, and removed the wiper blades. A male was assaulted during an altercation in Pilling. Unknown offenders broke into a shed on Garstang Road, Pilling, and stole fuel.

**ASB** – A resident reported concerns over the death of a pilot in fields near Fluke Hall Lane. A noisy party spilling out on to Garstang Road at Pilling caused a resident to complain about the anti-social behaviour.

**WD09/BC09 – Crimes** – A male was assaulted by another male on Park Lane. A pupil at St Aidans was found to be in possession of a small quantity of cannabis. A male in Knott End was assaulted by another male after a verbal altercation. A male offender stole items from the Co-op on Lancaster Road on three separate occasions in one day. A male in Preesall was assaulted by another male. Unknown offenders kicked a door panel in at a property on Park Lane but failed to gain entry. A young male found a video of child sexual abuse on social media and forwarded it to a number of others. A female took the keys out of a vehicle's ignition while it was parked up on Pilling Lane and drove away with them. A female in Knott End was assaulted by another female. A male was assaulted during a domestic dispute in Knott End. A male was bitten by a dog in Preesall. A male in Preesall was arrested for assaulting a police officer. A male in Knott End reported that another male had taken his car and driven it without his permission.

**ASB** – A male driving in Knott End reported being verbally abused by a cyclist. A female in Preesall reported being emotionally abused in a family dispute. A male reported poachers on Acres Lane, Preesall.

**WD10/BC10 – Crimes** – Offenders entered an insecure vehicle at a property on Market Street and removed property from it. An unknown offender threw a stone through a stained glass window at Hambleton Church causing a small hole. An unknown offender damaged toilets at Hambleton Village Hall. A female in Hambleton reported that a delivery driver claimed to have left a parcel for her with neighbours but she believed it had been stolen. A male smashed a car window while three females were sitting in the car at the Shovels. One female suffered minor injuries. Unknown offenders punctured all four tyres on a vehicle parked on Douglas Ave, Stalmine. A female in Stalmine reported that she had been assaulted by a male known to her. Unknown offenders forced the locking cap from a fuel tank on a farm on Shard Lane, Hambleton, and siphoned off a large quantity of heating oil.

**ASB** – A resident reported that a group of youths were damaging a bus stop on Grange Road, Hambleton. A female in Stalmine reported that a family member was damaging things in the property.
